

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FACT SHEET

The Student Teachers' Assistance through Reciprocation (STAR) Committee is pleased to offer the below-mentioned opportunities to current and prospective students of Church Teachers' College, Mandeville, Jamaica:

Kerr-Jarrett Hall Gift of Hope (estab. December 2012) is donated by Mrs. Marilyn Barnett, a member of the CTC Alumni Association Inc (CTCAAi) who established this Gift to provide hope for the future of young children, educated as a result of this contribution. It is envisaged that the recipient of this Gift will instil the hope of a better tomorrow through education delivered to the children he/she encounters. An Early Childhood graduate, Mrs. Barnett was a resident of Kerr-Jarrett Hall.

Specific requirements: Prospective or current student who is pursuing Early Childhood or Primary education.

Value of the scholarship: USD250.00 per year, available for the next five years. The Gift is valid for one year, and may be renewed based on the outcome of a subsequent application.

Mary Stewart Bright Futures Scholarship (estab. June 2013) donated by Ms. Hope Grant, member of the CTC Alumni Association Inc to provide a future in a Teaching /Educational career for graduates of Godfrey Stewart High School. Ms. Grant is a past student of Godfrey Stewart High School and Church Teachers' College.

Specific requirements: Prospective or current student who is a Godfrey Stewart High School graduate of the current year or year immediately prior to the current academic year.

Value of the scholarship: USD1,000.00 per year, available for the current year. The Scholarship is valid for one year.

Church Teachers' College Alumni Grant (estab. August 2014) donated by the Church Teachers' Alumni Association Inc (CTCAAi) to support the advancement in the teacher training of College students who have a desire to pursue a career in Education but lack all of the financial resources to do so. It was established in response to requests from the College to support students with this need.

Requirements: Current student pursuing an Education degree and experiencing financial crisis.

Value of the scholarship: USD100.00 per year, renewable each year by the current recipient. Seven such grants are currently available.

Alumni Physical Education Award (estab. August 2014) donated by the Church Teachers' Alumni Association Inc (CTCAAi) to promote the study of physical education in teacher training. It was inspired by a plea from Alumni and former lecturer at Church Teachers' College (CTC) at a Reunion of the Association.

Requirements: Current student pursuing an Education degree and experiencing financial crisis.

Value of the scholarship: USD250.00 per year, renewable each year by the current recipient.

Hettie Powell Sports Award (estab. January 2016) donated by Hettie Powell who was inspired by the mother of a young basketball player requiring financial assistance to attend College. The Award is intended to support current or prospective students who demonstrate sports talent and wish to pursue a teacher training diploma /degree at Church Teachers' College, Mandeville, Jamaica.

Requirements: Be a current or prospective student of Church Teachers' College, Mandeville, Jamaica who has demonstrated remarkable talent in sports.

Value of the scholarship: USD500.00 per year for 2 students, renewable each year by the current recipients.



Ken Thaxter Leadership Award (estab. March 2015) donated by the Church Teachers' Alumni Association Inc (CTCAAi) to recognize and support a third year CTC student who has demonstrated strong leadership skills during his /her first two years at the College. It is anticipated that he /she will continue this behaviour for the rest of his /her college life and beyond. The Award was so named after the Reverend Dr. Kenneth Thaxter who served Church Teachers' College (CTC) as principal and lecturer for more than thirty-one years.

Requirements: Be a third-year student of Church Teachers' College, Mandeville, Jamaica who has demonstrated strong leadership qualities during the first two years of attendance at CTC.

Value of the scholarship: USD250.00 per year, renewable each year by the current recipient.

Trisha Guy Award (estab. October 2023) donated by Mary Guy to support a current or prospective CTC student who has demonstrated a unique financial need that may continue throughout the College life. The Award was so named after Mary's daughter, Trisha, who went on to higher service in 2023.

Requirements: Be a current or prospective student of Church Teachers' College, Mandeville, Jamaica who has demonstrated a unique financial need.

Value of the scholarship: USD500.00 per year, renewable each year by the current recipient.

JSKL Scholarship for Mathematics/Science (estab. January 2024) donated by John Lawrence to support the interest and development of Mathematics and Science students. The initials represent John's named and those of his two daughters, one who pursued Mathematics /Statistics to eventually become an Actuary.

Requirements: Be a Mathematics /Science student of Church Teachers' College, Mandeville, Jamaica who maintains a high level (GPA3.5) of academic and pedagogic achievements and has demonstrated outstanding community development. **Value of the scholarship:** USD500.00 per year, renewable each year by the current recipient.

Receipt of these opportunities is available through an application process which may include an interview by the STAR panel. All applicants must be resident of Jamaica preceding the application and fulfil or exceed the academic requirements established by Church Teachers' College and the CTCAAi STAR Committee. Although not required, it is anticipated that the successful candidate will complete the proposed studies and work in the Jamaican education system after graduation. As CTC students, recipients must display his/her personal conduct at a level that befits the College's mission statement to "...develop positive attitudes, morals and values so as to be effective leaders in the communities they serve".
