



Mary Stewart Bright Futures Scholarship

Benefactor: Ms. Hope Grant is a member of the CTC Alumni Association Inc who established this Scholarship to provide a future in Teaching /Educational career for graduates of Godfrey Stewart High School.

Effective Date: September of each year or as soon as a recipient is identified by the CTCAAi STAR Committee.

Successful Candidate: Prospective or current student who is a graduate of Godfrey Stewart High School. The recipient must also display his/her personal conduct at a level that befits the College's mission statement to "...develop positive attitudes, morals and values so as to be effective leaders in the communities they serve".

STAR Committee: Members of the CTC Alumni Association Inc have been selected based on the Association's Bylaws. The Committee will review all applications including Personal Statements entitled: "Why I Should Be the Successful Candidate for the Mary Stewart Bright Futures Scholarship".

Value of the scholarship: USD1,000.00 per year. It is renewable based on the outcome of a subsequent application. The Scholarship is funded by Ms. Hope Grant, past student of Godfrey Stewart High School and Church Teachers' College.

The Scholarship will be disbursed by the CTCAAi following recommendation of its STAR Committee.

The Mary Stewart Bright Futures Scholarship is intended to provide an educational opportunity for graduating seniors of the Godfrey Stewart School in Savanna-la-Mar, Westmoreland, Jamaica. It is described as the "... futures scholarship" as it provides an opportunity for the future training for individuals who are keen on a career in Teaching /Educational training.

APPLYING FOR THIS AWARD

Consideration for this award is dependent on fulfilling the following requirements:

- Graduate of Godfrey Stewart High School, Savanna-la-Mar, Westmoreland, Jamaica
- Pursue an Education degree
- Fulfill or exceed the academic requirements established by Church Teachers' College and the CTCAAI STAR Committee
- Possess a 2.5 or higher grade point average (GPA)

Required documentation:

- A completed Application Form
- Proof of domicile in Jamaica
- Passport sized photo
- Personal statement entitled "Why I Should Be the Successful Candidate for the Mary Stewart Bright Futures scholarship"
- Copies of academic achievements and community awards
- Letter of acceptance from Church Teachers' College
- Cost of tuition, board, food, books and supplies
- Character References

All required documents must be submitted to receive consideration for the Scholarship

Evidence of the need to support selection of the Scholarship, will be strongly considered when reviewing your application.

Although not required, it is anticipated that you will successfully complete your proposed studies **and** work in the Jamaican education system after your studies.

Application for this Scholarship includes an interview by panelists of the CTCAAI STAR Committee. Consideration will not be given to applicants who do not attend an interview. Following the interviews, the panelists will submit recommendations to CTCAAI STAR Committee and Board of Directors.

The decision to award the Scholarship is based on eligibility of the applicant, interview, desire to pursue a Teaching /Education career, availability of funds and STAR Committee recommendation.

No family member of Hope Grant is eligible to apply.
